Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to remind existing parents and introduce new parents to our car parking procedures here at Guillemont.

In the morning, the long front car park is available for parents to park so they can drop off children near to school. Please pull into the bays to stop and make sure that your child does not run across the car park on route to either of the pedestrian entrances for their own safety. When people just stop in the middle of the car park and let their child out, other drivers cannot always see them and this could cause a nasty accident.

We have had several complaints about non blue badge owners using the disabled parking bays. Due to the high proportion of disabled parents and children I can not stress enough that these bays are for disabled drivers **only** and that the blue badge must be displayed at all times.

Due to a previous incident, in the afternoon the front car park will be closed, this is because it becomes very congested with everyone arriving at the same time. The side car park is for the use of disabled drivers and the Hampshire County Council taxis that pick up our special needs children only.

Finally, can I please ask that you park sensibly and legally in the area surrounding the school, being considerate to our neighbours. Parking on double yellow lines, zigzag yellow lines and on pavements causes a hazard to other drivers, pedestrians and is illegal. Our PSCO does visit to check parking regularly so please be careful.

Thank you for parking safely.
