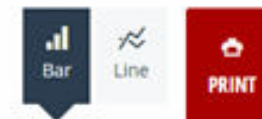

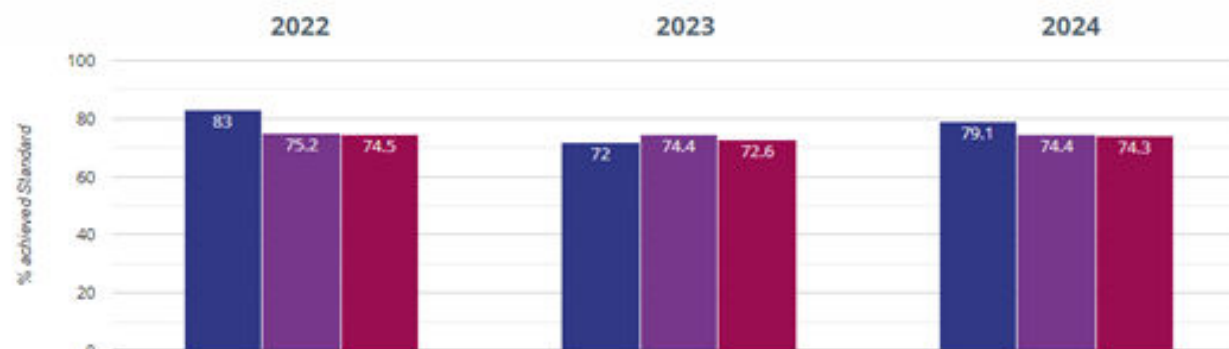

Reading - achieved standard



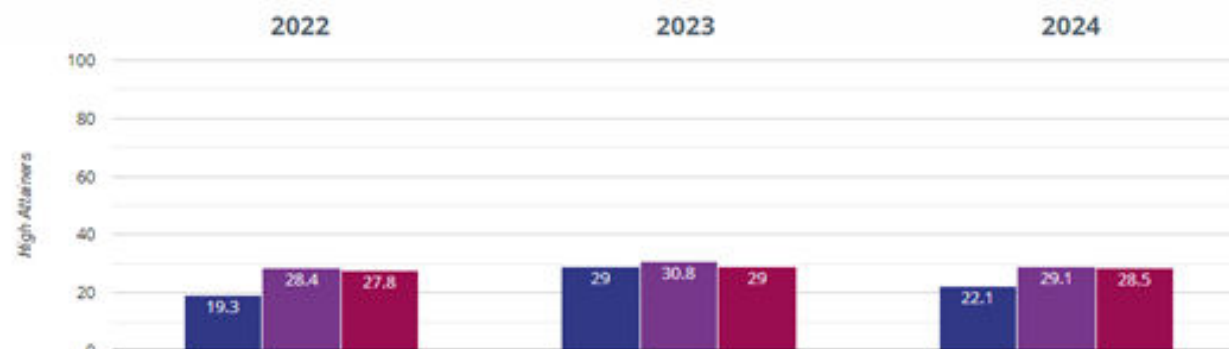

Reading - high attainers



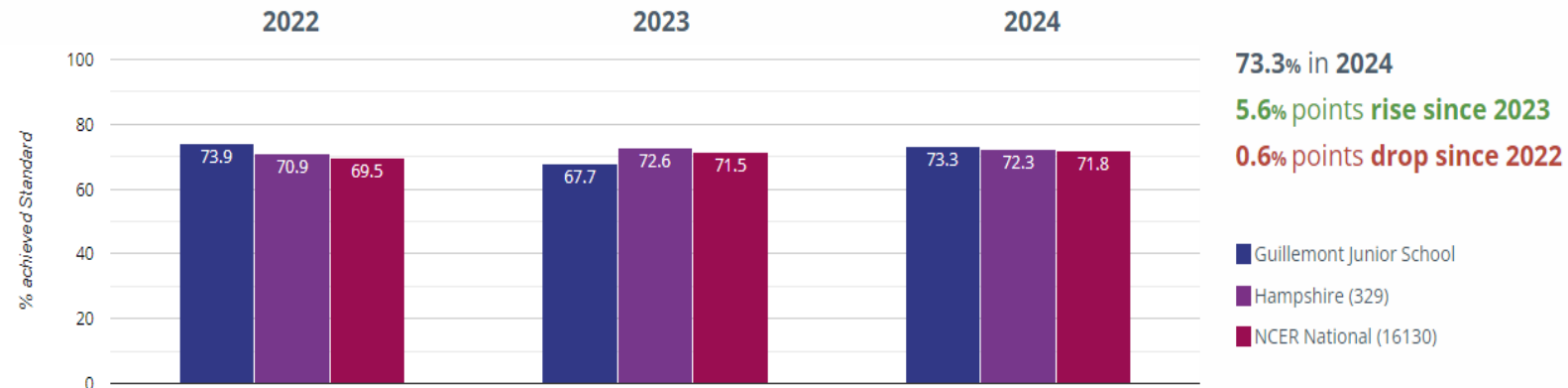

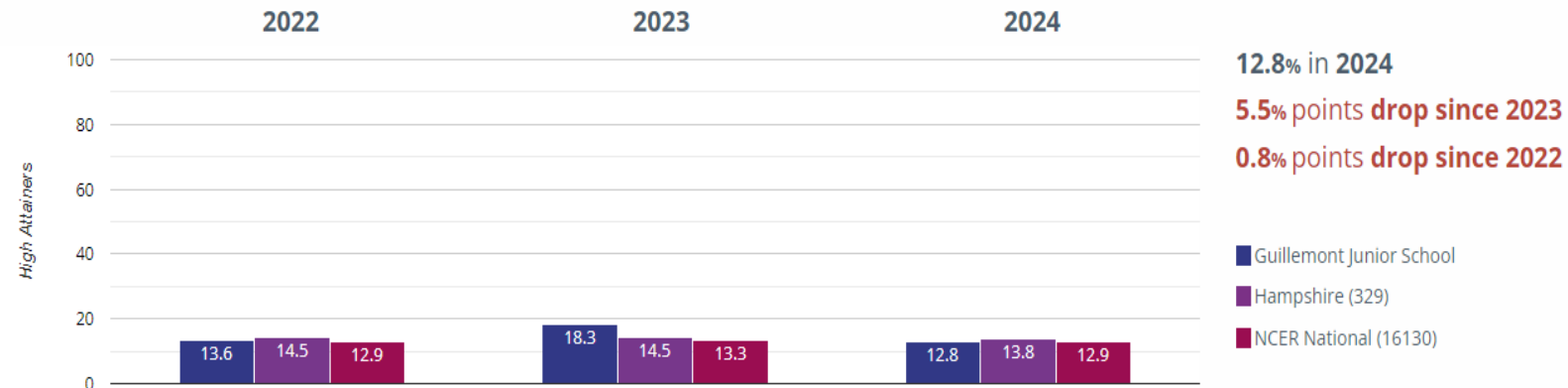

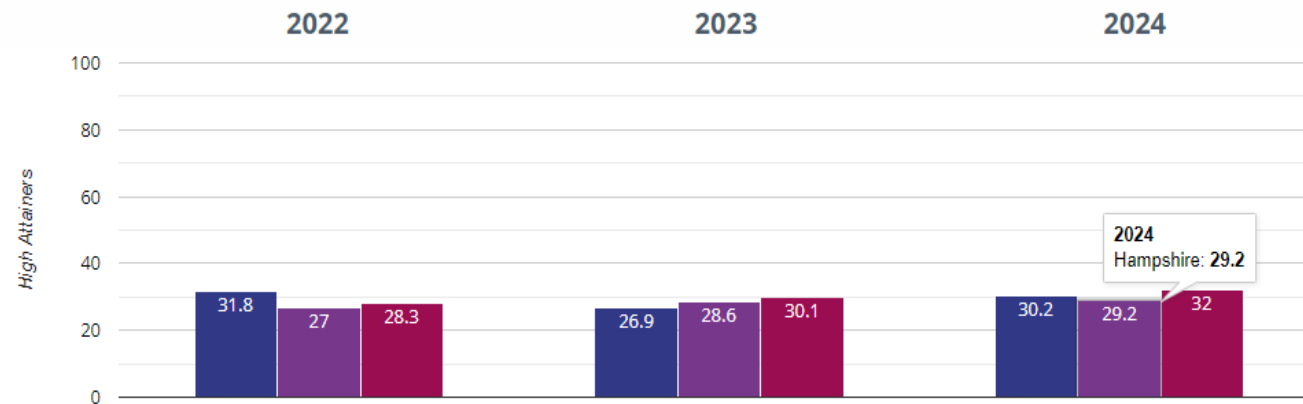
Writing - achieved standard

? GPS - high attainers

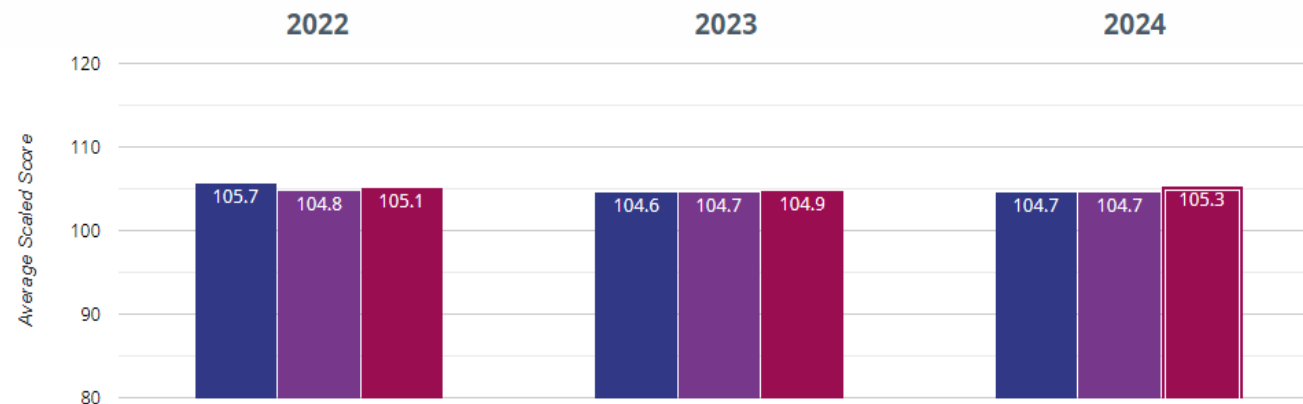

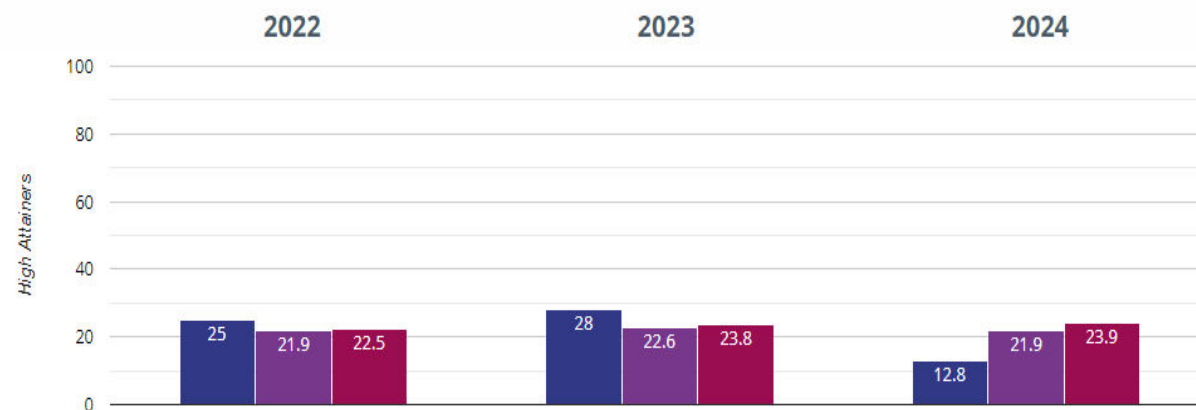
