Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 6 Revision at home - Key Stage 2 National Test (SATs)

Your child has today been issued with two Key Stage 2 revision guides, a homework plan and a note book. Please take a few moments to read this information.

The new revision guides do have some areas for children to show their responses to questions – **please ensure they do not complete this in the actual guide but in the notebook provided** as we will be using them with next year's children.

Please ensure your child follows along with the revision timetable at home, this will mean they are working alongside the curriculum in school and identify if they have any gaps in learning that we can address as soon as possible. Revising at home will also help your child get into a good routine for the homework they will receive when they start Senior School in September.

We expect the children to bring their revision notebook in to show their teacher every Friday. This will help us to keep track of their revision progress and to help address any misconceptions at an early stage.

All Yr6 children sit written assessments during their final year at junior school, during the week commencing **Monday 12th May 2025**. Their performance is recorded and, like all other National Curriculum Assessments, is stored for statistical purposes. Secondary schools may use this information to place children in appropriate teaching groups. This will mean that Guillemont children are well placed to make the best progress they can towards both KS3 assessments and GCSE Grades.

A virtual meeting has been arranged for **Tuesday 28th January at 6pm** which will cover all aspects of preparing for the KS2 assessments and give you the opportunity to understand what is expected and how you can support your child at this important time.
